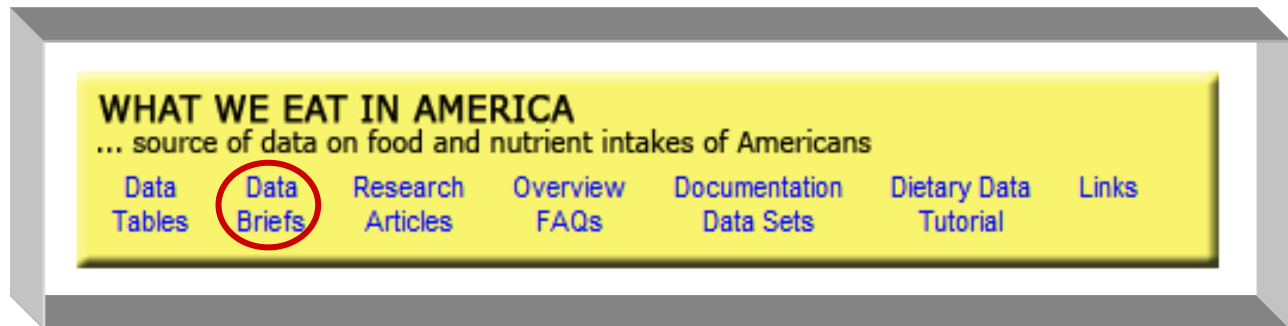




DIETARY DATA BRIEFS
