


1980 → 2012

Since 1980, obesity prevalence among children and adolescents has almost tripled.




Approximately 12.5 million or 17% of children and adolescents aged 2 to 19 years are obese.

U.S. Childhood Obesity Trends




American Indian & Alaskan Native (2-4 years old)
