# **Building the Field**

- NCCOR's design and accomplishments helped build a field of childhood obesity research
- Based on work by Janice Petrovich:
  - Delineate a common purpose by identifying key knowledge gaps
  - Create a shared identity/affiliation around a common purpose
  - Develop structures for democratic/respectful collaboration so as to strategically coordinate efforts for maximum national impact
